

Grain Pocket Installation Instructions

To install the *Grain Pockets* simply stretch the elastic cord at the bottom of the pocket wide enough to slide it down over the shelf. The pocket goes on the textured side of the shelf with the flap facing up. Continue sliding the elastic cord down until it rests in the notches cut in the sides of the shelf.



Stretch the elastic cord at the top of the pocket and place over the shelf and into the notches at the angled corners of the shelf. That's all there is to installing the *Stable Grazer Grain Pockets*.

Operating Instructions

1. Grab the opening of the *Grain Pocket* and lift until the shelf is at about a 45° angle. Pour your grain or supplement into the pocket. You may need to shake the pocket slightly for the grain to flow in. Do not overfill the pocket.



2. Lay the shelf back down. Pull the crease tight and fold the top of the pocket over. This is necessary to prevent the grain from spilling out. If you want to feed only grain in this feeding go ahead and swing the shelf up into the load position. If you want to feed hay and grain at the same time go to step 3.



3. Lay the hay flake on top of the pocket and swing the shelf up into the load position. The hay and grain will drop at the same time.



Each *Grain Pocket* will hold up to approximately 3 pounds of grain. The *Grain Pockets* are easily moved from shelf to shelf or you can put one on each shelf and feed small amounts of grain with each feeding. The amount of grain in any feeding will determine how much hay can be fed in the same feeding. The more grain the less hay and vice versa.
